PREVENTION EDUCATOR

The person will be responsible for:

BASIC FUNCTION

To assist men enrolled in the Long Island Fatherhood Initiative (LIFI) program in their efforts to become responsible, committed, and nurturing fathers. The Prevention Specialist will help dads strengthen their connection and involvement in the lives of their children by teaching programs addressing:

- healthy family relationships
- domestic violence prevention
- economic stability

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Promote responsible parenting among low-income, at-risk fathers by delivering/facilitating the 24/7 Dad curriculum.
- Preventing family violence and child abuse/neglect by delivering/facilitating the 24/7 Dad Understanding Domestic Violence “booster” curriculum training on the impact of domestic violence on families.
- Enhancing the financial well-being of Probation/CPS/Family Court involved fathers using the 24/7 Dad Non-Custodial Dad “booster” curriculum including child support, money management, visitation, and workforce readiness.
- Maintain records of all client activities completed on nFORM and other required data collection platforms including individual client charts.
- Disburse incentives earned by completion of 24/7 Dad parenting workshop and Domestic Violence booster session.
- Participate in all professional development opportunities including but not limited to on-going training at conferences and webinars addressing *Fatherhood, Healthy Relationships, Domestic Violence* and *Economic Stability* issues.
- Working as a part of a team to deliver a range of community outreach and engagement activities to promote services offered through the LIFI program to prospective partner organizations including but not limited to probation/parole, Drug and Family Court, CPS, homeless shelters, transitional and recovery housing facilities.



- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's degree preferred with a minimum of two years of experience in social services, group presentations or teaching.
- Bilingual - (English/Spanish) a plus.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Willingness to work as a supportive team member.
- Working familiarity with Microsoft Office, Google Docs, and virtual platforms (zoom, google meet, etc).
